ITINERARY

May 8	Depart Canada.
May 9 - Beijing	Arrive Beijing, meet your guide and transfer to hotel.
May 10	Visit the Great Wall (Mutianyu section) Note: Additional fee will be charged (see page 8). If you choose the cable car/chair lift/slide down the wall (this additional fee to be paid upon arrival at Great Wall). Stop at a jade factory on the way home. (B, L)
May 11	Explore the Imperial Gardens of the Summer Palace in the morning and visit a local Hutong (with a pedi-cab ride!) in the afternoon. (B, L)
May 12 – Xi-an	Visit Tiananmen Square and Forbidden city in the morning. After lunch travel to Xi'an either by plane or high speed train (5 hours). (B, L)
May 13	In the morning, explore the Terra Cotta Warriors and in the afternoon walk on top of the 950 year old City Wall. (B, L)
May 14	Visit the Big Wild Goose Pagoda in the morning and in the afternoon, proceed to the airport for your flight to the orphanage city. Your guide will meet you upon arrival and transfer you to your hotel. (B, L)
May 15 Provincial Capital	Visit orphanage and finding site. (B)
May 16	Local sightseeing. (B)
May 17 – Guilin	Depart hotel for the airport where you will take a morning flight to Guilin. In the afternoon, you will visit the Reed Flute Caves to see the spectacular views created by the underground atmosphere and also see the colourful light displays throughout the caves. (B, L)
May 18	After breakfast, embark on a scenic cruise along the Li River and enjoy lunch on board. Depart the cruise at around 2:30 and wander around the famous Yangshuo West Street. (B, L)
May 19 - Shanghai	In the morning, stroll along the beautiful lake in the city and in the afternoon, head to the airport for your flight to Shanghai. (B, L)

May 20	Visit Bund and YuYuan Gardens in the morning. Yuyuan Market shopping in the afternoon as well as a tour through the alleys of the old city neighbourhoods learning the history and culture of Shanghai. (B, L)
May 21	In the morning, take van (approximately 1 hour) to Zhujiajiao (watertown). This amazing town was established about 1,700 years ago! Enjoy a fabulous acrobat show in the evening to end your adventure! (B, L, D)
May 22	Transfer to airport for flight home. (B)

B = Breakfast, L = Lunch, D = Dinner

QUOTE

Costs below are based on a minimum of 15 paying adults in the tour group. Costs will be higher (up to \$200/person) if fewer adults are travelling and will be modified upon registration deadline, if required.

Basic Tour:

5 star accommodations – Beijing – Xi'an – Guilin – Shanghai

All fees are quoted in **US dollars** and are per person. Children aged 12 and up (at time of travel) are considered adults for travel purposes in China.

Each room will have 2 double beds.

The above quotation includes:

A welcome at the airport and escort to hotel, **5 star** hotel accommodations, meals as per itinerary, sightseeing and entrance fees (some exclusions as noted), guide service, flights/trains from Beijing – Xi'an – Guilin - Shanghai, all taxes.

Orphanage Visit – ADDITIONAL COST

The cost for one orphanage visit will vary depending on the city but will average about \$900USD **per adult** and \$750USD **per child** (including airfare from Xi'an – provincial capital – Guilin, accommodations, transportation to orphanage, guide, etc.).

Once I have all of the details for your orphanage visit, I'll request a quote from our in-China rep and forward this information to you. It can take 2 – 3 weeks to obtain your quote.

Additional Fees

Mutianyu Great Wall Cable Car/Slide/Chair Lift: 120RMB/adult, 100RMB/child (if over 1.2 metres will pay adult fare) – payable upon arrival at Great Wall, double way cable/slide is 120RMB/person

Effective January 1, 2019, every person (except those under 14 and over 70 and a few other exceptions) must attend, **in person**, a visa centre to have their fingerprints taken. There are only 5 applicable visa centres – Toronto, Ottawa, Montreal, Calgary and Vancouver. The Toronto centre services Ontario and Manitoba and the Ottawa centre accept applications from Quebec, PEI, Nova Scotia, Newfoundland and Nunavut.

For those in provinces other than Alberta and Ontario, this will add an additional expense.

IN-CHINA TRAVEL (QUOTED AND PAYABLE IN USD)

Basic Tour

Please note that each room contains two (2) beds unless otherwise requested.

*In-China travel includes: hotel, guide service, transportation to/from sites, airport/train stations and hotels, some meals (as outlined on itinerary), sightseeing, all flights and trains within China and all taxes.

Please note: There may be other costs that will vary. All international flights and in-China travel fees are set and charged by third parties and must be paid at the current rate at the time they are due.

There may be changes from when you initially received this cost information until you receive a final quote for your in-China travel (approximately 60 days prior to travel). Adults are travellers aged 12 and older. This applies to fares on international flights as well as in-China travel fees.

HOMELAND VISIT ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS

The costs per family were quoted above. Please note that children ages 12 and up (at time of travel) are considered adults for travel in China.

Hotels are family friendly and rated 5 stars in China. They were selected for their location and comfort and are more than suitable for the average family. Most will have a pool as well as a variety of restaurants nearby with a varied choice of food. In Beijing the hotel is close to both western style and Chinese restaurants. Hotels in each province are to be confirmed at a later date. Hotels will all have 2 beds. In some locations, the beds are standard size.

Indicate by checking the appropriate box which option you prefer. Payment for the in-China travel (below) is due upon receipt of individual itinerary. Cheques/money orders must be in US funds and are made payable to "The Children's Bridge". This payment will be wired to the travel coordinators in China. Should you not be able to come on the tour, cancellation penalties will apply.

ORPHANAGE VISIT ARRANGEMENTS

The Children's Bridge will arrange a visit to your child's orphanage. Your request will be made through the Department of Civil Affairs in each province. Such visits are approved both by the Department of Civil Affairs and the Director of your child's orphanage. While every effort will be made on your behalf to visit the orphanage, there is no guarantee that it will be allowed.

In order to make the request, the following *adoption document* is required:

1. Copy of your child's Adoption Certificate (**red book** with family photo) with complete Chinese name, year of adoption, birth date, etc.

If you would like to visit any particular orphanage staff or foster family, please provide any details that you have (names, addresses, photos, etc.).

FINDING SITE

If you wish to visit your child's abandonment/finding site, please scan and email me a copy of his/her abandonment certificate. This will be a white booklet that may say "Notarial Certificate" on it. Ensure that inside, it indicates where your child was abandoned. Note that often the site noted in the booklet no longer exists.

- Ensure all travellers have received necessary immunizations. Twinrix (recommended) must be started 6 months prior to travel. Dukoral is also recommended for all travellers.
- We will book your international flights or you can book directly with the airline or agency of your choice (using points if you choose to). Please provide me with copies of your e-tickets ASAP. You also have the option of travelling early or staying longer if you like.
 - We use the services of Eastview Travel to book all international airfare. Eastview Travel is located at 780 Somerset Street West (2nd Floor), Ottawa, ON, K1R 6R2, Tel: 613-232-9461
- Every person travelling must apply for and obtain a Chinese visa (this is simply a stamp in your passport). I'll send you the link after I receive your registration package and I have your hotel details and Invitation Letter from the in-China travel service as you must include this information in your application. Note that you will need to submit your passports and 2 colour visa sized pictures (2" x 2").

Important: Passports must be signed and valid for 6 months following dates of travel.

- **For all children travelling to China (adopted) for the first time, please include their **red Chinese passport** with your visa application as well as adoption documents.**
-
- **Effective January 1, 2019, every person (except those under 14 and over 70 and a few other exceptions) must attend, in person, a visa centre to have their fingerprints taken. There are only 5 applicable visa centres – Toronto, Ottawa, Montreal, Calgary and Vancouver.**
- Attend your Homeland Pre-Travel Meeting (or schedule a call) – The meeting will be scheduled for mid-April and we ask that all attend, if possible.
